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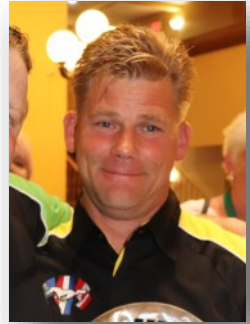
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President's report A.K.A.

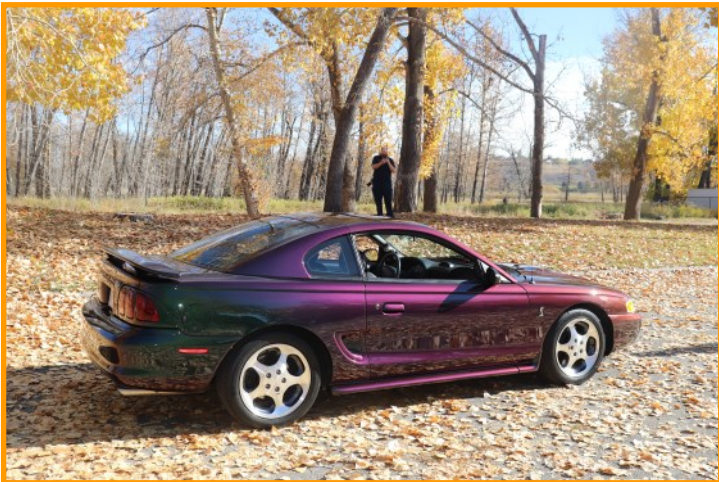


The AMAC Fall Photo Shoot & Picnic in Fish Creek Park was a great event, hopefully to be repeated next year.
