### 2016 - Our Sixth Mustang a 2005 GT Convertible





### 2019 - Our seventh (& current) Mustang a 2019 Shelby GTH







We factory ordered a 2019

# DRAGSTRIP MEMORIES SHOW HAMILTON ON — *Ken Werner*




