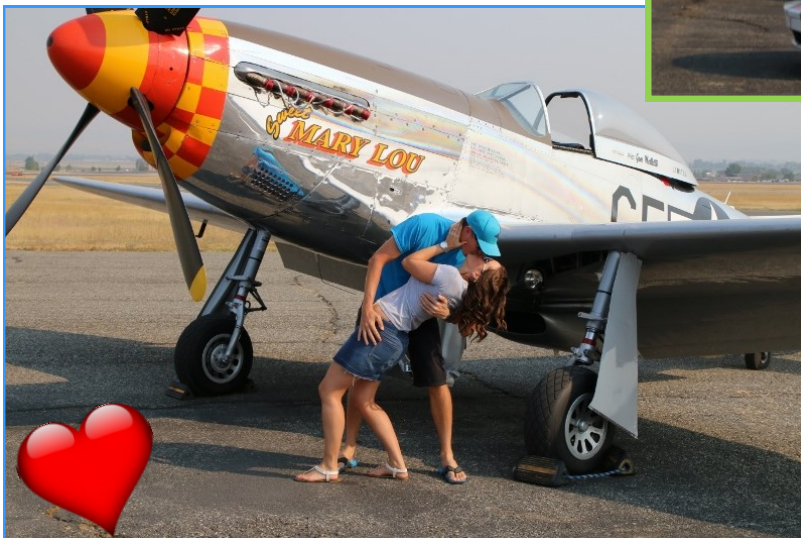

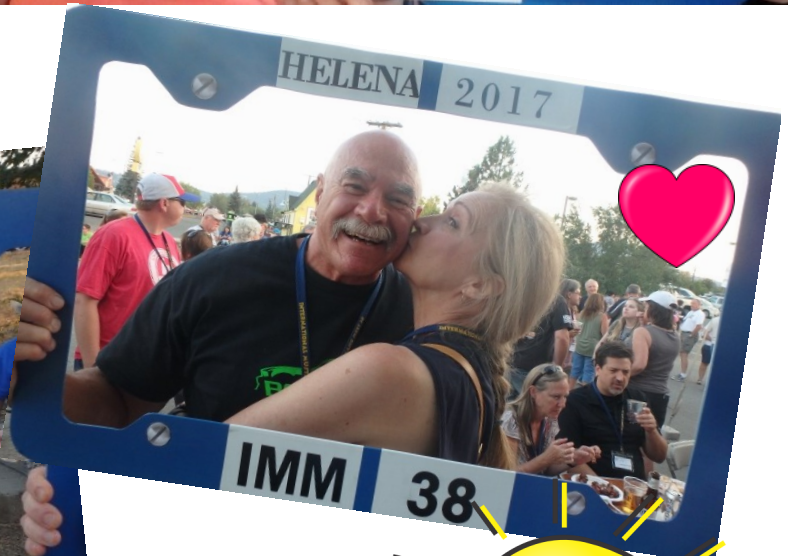

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IMM Fall Meeting 2017

The IMM Fall Meeting was held on Sunday September 03, in Helena, MT. There are eleven Clubs that presently belong to the IMM, with nine clubs having reps at the meeting. The Clubs absent were Missoula and Winnipeg.

The Boise Idaho Mustang Club (Treasure Valley Mustang and Ford Club) had previously shown some interest in joining the IMM. There were multiple members from Boise at IMM 38 in Helena. In fact, the draw for the free room was won by one of the Boise members. During the IMM meeting, one of their Club Executive gave an "intro" about their Club. Based out of Boise, they currently have 95 family memberships, and have been in existence for 34 years. Some info on them can be found here:

Their Club will decide by next April if they want to apply to join IMM.

If they apply, then the IMM Clubs are to decide if they want to welcome Boise into the IMM. Members of each Club are to let their Reps know how they feel. Another detail is that Boise is about 1400 kms (870 miles) from Calgary.

Another discussion point was around IMM having an "IMM website" created as well as an ongoing Facebook page. Becky from Bozeman has volunteered to manage the creation and management of the website. Suggestions are still open for the website name. (there was a suggestion list up at the banquet on Sunday night). The IMM has approved some nominal monies to get the site set up and running.

Helena had around 345 cars registered for IMM 38. Their members accomplished a lot, considering the size of their Club. The weather – wow, was it warm!

The Great Falls Club indicated they are working on hosting IMM 40 in 2019. Nothing is truly finalized yet, but they are looking at having the Heritage Inn as the Host Hotel, one again. We will be getting updates from them at the Spring Meeting in April.

Edmonton is progressing well on IMM39 and will be holding the meet at the Executive Hotel in Nisku, just north of Leduc. This is on the east side of Highway 2, just across from the Edmonton International Airport. This keeps them close to the Castrol Raceway drag strip, Reynolds Museum and the Hotel parking lot has room for 400 cars. A cruise to Shelby Canada West is also in the works, along with a Saturday night BBQ, and more. Edmonton will also have a draw for free Hotel room, at the Spring meeting.

The IMM Spring meeting will be held in Calgary in April 2018. Watch for updates regarding it.

There was a discussion around the rotation of the upcoming IMM events. Some Clubs were looking for confirmation as to what the next several years schedule actually looks like. In response to that the IMM Secretary, Deb Taylor, forwarded the information to the International Reps, to distribute to their members.

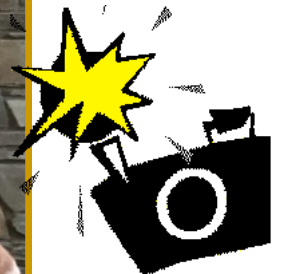

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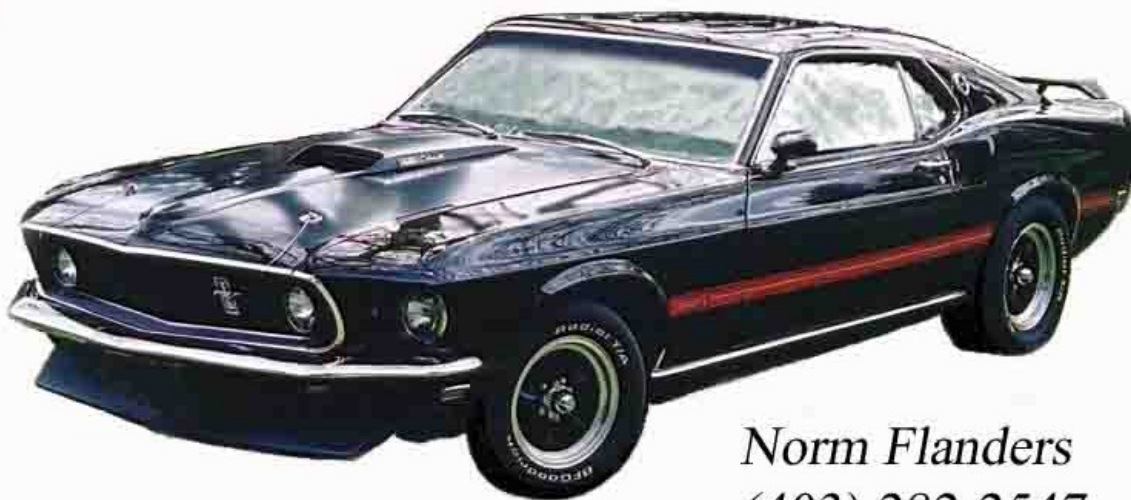
